Where IS DREAM located?

When we are out and about in the community we are frequently asked...Where is Dream located? As you may know, we do not have a facility; we operate with primarily foster homes (or short-term boarding when there are no open foster homes). "MEET & GREET" events (showcasing our adoptable friends) are scheduled routinely throughout the year at different locations : YMCA (in Troy), Edison Community College (Wellness Day), Kroger Adoption days (twice a year), Miami County Home Show (Feb at Hobart Arena), Tipp City Mum festival, Englewood festival, Fulton Farm Sweet Corn festival, and Rpets . Socialization is "enrichment" AND an important way for our adoptable pooches to meet new (human) friends; that is why you have seen us (dogs and volunteers) at various locations in the Miami County community. **We know every venture into the community benefits our rescued pets; volunteers are always needed to help at our booth or train with our furry friends. Will you RE-home my pet?

Throughout the year we receive requests from individuals to help rehome their personal dog for a variety of reasons. We provide assistance for re-homing when the owner can meet the following requirements 1) vet records must be current and dog must be spayed or neutered, and 2) he/she must provide current pictures of the pet and continued quality care for the dog until he/she is adopted, 3) a rehoming form and owner surrender form is required, along with a donation to DREAM for our time and effort and vet expenses we may incur for assisting with rehoming a personal pet. *The Re-homing page at Dream4pets.org provides details and forms for rehoming a personal dog, and ADOPTAPET.com has great information as well. Rehoming is never a quick or easy process...* consideration is given to the breed, age, health, vet records, socialization level, and energy it can take anywhere from 6 weeks to 6 months, or longer. DREAM's focus and mission is and has always been to save the life of a shelter dog, rehabilitate and rehome, and our very few foster homes are reserved for this endeavor. Brave Breed rescue (BBR) group and Our Farm Sanctuary (OFS) are 2 new resources now available to help as well, located in Miami County.
