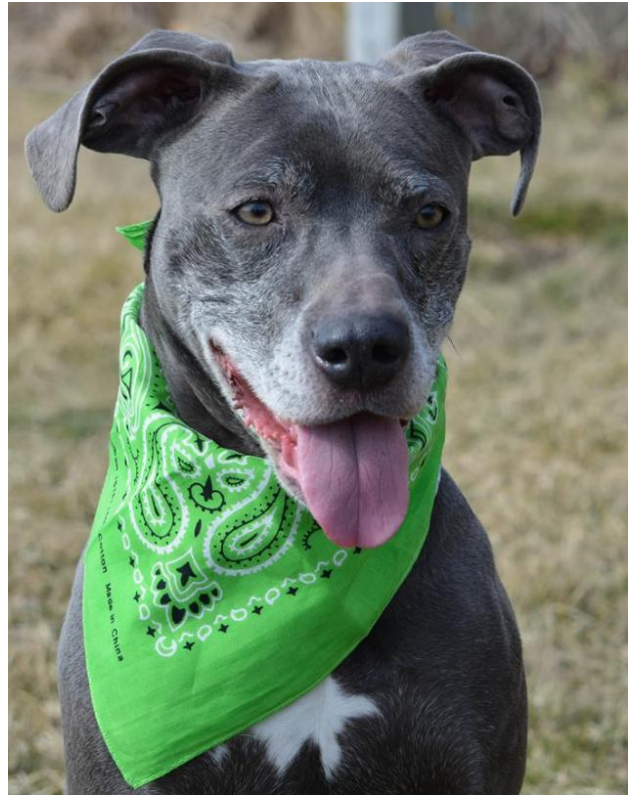


Sheba is a beauty! She is an active senior (8-9 years of age) dog. She is spayed, current on vaccines, microchipped, heartworm negative, and on monthly prevention. A girl who enjoys rolling around with her Jolly Ball and sniffing for something to chase. She would be a great walking or short-distance running buddy. Sheba will also be happy to keep the couch warm for you. Since she does have a very strong prey drive, we require she have the safety of a physical fence as opposed to an invisible one. Because of her prey drive, we feel it would be best that she is the only pet in the home to prevent any possible altercations that might result from her desire to chase whatever catches her eye.



Due to her speed and strength, Sheba should probably be in a home with older children. She needs an experienced dog owner that knows how to be a leader and provide and reinforce structure and boundaries. It may seem as though a lot of conditions are attached to Sheba. Here are some of the reasons why. She was released to an animal shelter by her original owners who didn't want to deal with her energy level. She was taken in by a local rescue. We provided free housing and daily care for her--they have no facility--while they looked for a foster or permanent home. After some time, that group was able to find a foster family. The foster family worked with a certified trainer to help her become better behaved and more adoptable. The foster family fell in love with her, and after about 8 months, decided in 2014 to adopt her. The certified trainer continued working with her for the new family. In Summer 2016 the original rescue group was contacted by the family

saying they were giving Sheba up, so that rescue readily took her back. We were, again, able to house and provide daily care for the returning Sheba. In December, 2016 we requested and were given custody of Sheba by the previous rescue. She is a wonderful, sweet girl and we take seriously our responsibility to find her the best possible safe, loving, permanent home. Hopefully #3 will be the charm. (We find that we must limit our adoption area to between 1 and 1 1/2 hours from Troy, Ohio.)
