Fostering a dog HELPS them through their rehabilitation process and prepares him/her for the next forever home. Dogs that come to us have often been family pets in the past, but released to the shelter (owner surrender) or found as a stray. We adopt (rescue) dogs from county shelters in OHIO and then they are placed directly into vet care. Foster care is the next step. FOSTERING helps HEAL their broken heart, REBUILD the bond of trust with

humans, ESTABLISHES rules, routine, exercise, and REINFORCES "good manners and good behavior". We provide food, vet care, toys, bedding, and a crate (if needed) during the foster period. When Ready for Adoption they are showcased and promoted online ;-)
